

City of Green River, City Council Proceedings for April 6, 2021, 7 pm, in Council Chambers, Mayor Pete Rust called the meeting to order. The following Council Members were present: Gary Killpack, Sherry Bushman, George Jost, Mike Shutran, Robert Berg, and Jim Zimmerman. The Mayor opened the hearing at 7:32 pm. There were no comments or concerns presented. The Mayor closed the hearing at 7:32 pm. **Council Actions:** (A) Consideration to Approve a New Retail Liquor License Application from the Tomahawk Tavern, LLC. Council Member Berg moved to enter into an agreement with RaNae Johnson dba; The Snak Shak, LLC to operate the concession stands at Stratton Myers and Veterans Parks for the 2021 season, pending legal approval. Council Member Bushman seconded, motion carried; (D) Consideration to Approve an Amended and Restated Cooperative Agreement for the Urban Systems Program. Council Member Bushman moved to authorize the Mayor to sign the Amended and Restated Cooperative Agreement among the Wyoming Department of Transportation, City of Green River and Sweetwater County. Council Member Shutran seconded, motion carried; (E) Consideration to Authorize the Submission of a Grant to the Wyoming Emergency Management Program. Council Member Jost moved to authorize the Parks & Recreation Department to submit a 2021 WEIMP Grant application to the Wyoming Department of Agriculture.
