



2021 Spring Co-ed Volleyball League

1. Team Captain responsibilities:
 - a. Submit completed team roster on time
 - b. Attend or send a team representative to the Captain's Meeting
 - c. Collect Team Fees and submit them on time
 - d. Notify Recreation Supervisor of scheduling conflicts/game change
 - e. Notify team of League Rules and ensure your team abides by them
2. Rosters are due by 9:00 PM on Friday, February 19th at the Green River Recreation Center. Teams will be accepted on a first come/first serve basis. We will be limiting the number of teams based on available gym space.
3. Two divisions are being offered. "A" Division for the more advanced players and a "B" Division for less-skilled players. Please indicate on your roster form which division your team wants to play.
4. A Captain's Meeting will be on Tuesday, February 23rd, 6:00 PM at the Green River Recreation Center to discuss scheduling and rules. **AT LEAST ONE PERSON FROM EACH TEAM MUST ATTEND THIS MEETING.**
5. **Due to Covid-19, each team will need to follow the guidelines provided by the State and our local Health Department.**
 - a. This proposal would meet the current State guidelines for groups of no more than 50.
 - b. No spectators will be allowed in the gym at any time. This includes children of players.
 - c. Teams will need to leave the gym immediately after the game is over. The incoming teams may enter the gym once the previous teams have completely left.
 - d. Teams must maintain social distancing when entering and leaving the facility.
 - e. The game schedule will allow plenty of time between games to allow for easy transition of teams.
 - f. Each team will be required to hand sanitize before each game, hand sanitizer will be provided for your protection.
 - g. After each game, the team captain or other designated player, will sanitize each volleyball before the next game starts. This cleaner will be provided.
 - h. We recommend that players do not share equipment or personal items with teammates.
 - i. We recommend that players who are not actively playing and "on the bench" wear face coverings and sit six feet apart if possible.
 - j. Team meetings must honor the social distancing requirements.
 - k. All players will be asked to sign a Covid waiver before playing their first game of the season.
 - l. All players will "sign in" each night on the scoresheet. This will help with contact tracing if we have an exposure
 - m. We understand that there are many new requirements this season. The Green River Parks and Recreation Department is following the State and Local Health Department requirements. If the requirements are changed, we will implement a new/modified plan for our program. We appreciate your understanding and support.
6. League play begins Tuesday, March 2nd and ends mid-May.
7. Games are played on Tuesdays and Thursdays, in the evenings, at the Green River Recreation Center. Two courts are used at the same time (2 games will be played at the same time). Game times will be determined after we determine the number of teams we have and which division they are in.
8. Each team will play once or twice/week, depending on the number of teams registered.
9. Team fees are \$85/team. **Teams will be required to pay the \$85 League Fee when they turn in their roster. Rosters will not be accepted without payment.** Make checks payable to GRRC.
10. Teams may make roster changes until 9:00 PM on Tuesday, April 6th.

11. At this time, there is no evening GRRC Nursery Service. If it opens during the season, teams will be notified.
12. Players associated with the league do not have to pay admission to the Recreation Center when entering the facility to participate in league games.
13. Schedules will be available Thursday, February 25th, after 4:00 PM at the Green River Recreation Center. Schedules will be emailed to Team Captains and available on the City Website or at the Front Desk.
14. Individuals without a team can put their name and phone number on the sign-up sheet at the front desk. These names and phone numbers will be made available to the team captains to fill vacancies on their rosters.
